STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



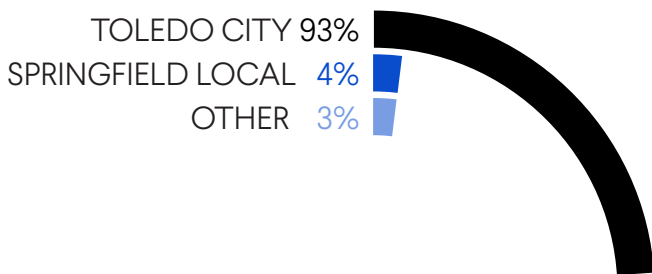

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Western Toledo Preparatory Academy (WTPA) achieved one of the strongest starts as a new school within the ACCEL Schools network, earning it the title of ACCEL Rookie School of the Year.

All grade levels met or exceeded the state’s student growth expectations in English Language Arts, Math & Science, earning WTPA a 4-star rating in Progress. 100% of students met the Third Grade Reading requirements for promotion to Grade 4. The school additionally earned a four-star rating for exceeding state standards in closing educational gaps.
